The Zululand Rhino Reserve has a vital population of rhino which are under threat.

We have begun losing rhino to poachers who kill them for their horns. Sadly, the horns are mistakenly believed to contain medicinal and aphrodisiac qualities as well being used as trinkets.

With heavy hearts and out of desperation to keep our rhino alive, we have taken this drastic step and decided to dehorn our entire population. After evaluating all other alternatives and weighing up the pros and cons, we came to the decision that this is the best way forward to protect our rhino population. We have invested heavily in security and will continue to do so and dehorning is only one of the many facets of protecting our wildlife.



Dehorning is a harmless operation whereby a qualified veterinarian removes the horn of a rhino. This is a quick, painless procedure, after which, the rhino runs off unharmed.
